The applicant must be a Switzerland of Ohio Local School District graduating high school senior or graduate, or a child or grandchild of a member of MCRTA who is or will be enrolled in an accredited 4-year college program preparing **to become a teacher**. The MCRTA committee must receive all applications and supporting school principal or guidance counselor records no later than **Friday, December 6, 2024**. Upon confirmation of enrollment from a qualified college a check in the amount of \$750.00 will be presented to each recipient chosen.
